2. **DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES:** Mailed entry due **September 16, 2009** Email entry due **September 21, 2009**.
ALL ENTRY FEES, INCLUDING EMAIL FEES, MUST BE PAID BEFORE JUDGING STARTS.

The secretary will call the exhibitor collect if any information is missing from an entry.

3. **Changes** may be phoned in to the secretary at **209.838.7881** or emailed to **morrisrex@yahoo.com**
4. **Ear changes** may be made the day of the show at the table. The exhibitor is responsible for making sure changes are made to judging cards and control sheets. Day-of-show changes in class, sex, or variety must be made with the show secretary for the same fee as the original entry fee. Add-ons may be made the day of the show for a fee of \$6.00 per rabbit per show.
5. **One exhibitor** per entry form, please. If you need additional forms, you may copy the entry form or use a blank 8.5x11 sheet of paper. **BE SURE YOUR ENTRY INFORMATION IS LEGIBLE & UNAMBIGUOUS!** Call the show secretary if you have any questions as to how to list your entries.
6. Youth may enter both open and youth shows using different animals but **must use** separate entry forms for open and youth shows.
7. We will charge exhibitor \$35 or bank fee (whichever is greater) for any returned checks.

SHOW RULES

1. This is an ARBA-sanctioned Double Open-Double Youth, one-day carrying cage show. This show will be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA. Your entry indicates your acceptance of these rules. All cages must be leak-proof. **Please trim your rabbit's toenails before the show.** Any unhealthy rabbits must be removed promptly from the showroom.
2. Showroom will be open at **7 a.m.** **Judging will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m.**
3. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly marked in the left ear.
4. All rabbits are entered at the owner's risk. Every precaution will be taken to safeguard and minimize hazards, losses, and mistakes, but show personnel, judges, and the Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds are in no way responsible for death or injury to any animal or person.
5. **Exhibitors are responsible for making sure their entry information is correct including judging cards,** and for getting their rabbits to and from the judging tables. There will be no recalling of classes for missed rabbits. **Check your judging cards for accuracy when you put your rabbits on the table. Judging for Show B may start before Show A finishes.**
6. The ARBA host club (RPSCV) reserves the right to refuse entries from all locations within 150 miles which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within the past 60 days of the entry deadline.
7. **All entry fees, including email fees, must be paid in full before judging starts.** There will be no refunds of exhibitor fees. Should you enter but not attend, you will be billed for your entry fees. Your mail or email entry is a contract between you and RPSCV, and fees are payable regardless of your attendance. (If you have a legitimate emergency & will not attend, contact Trina Carlson, show super, regarding your entry fees.)
8. Space is limited in the building. Rabbits take precedence over people space. Please keep walkways clear. **Chairs, grooming tables, and other belongings may not be set up until after 9am,** when all rabbits are in place.
9. We are guests on the fairgrounds; please behave responsibly. You will be held financially liable for any expenses RPSCV is charged for misbehavior or damage to the premises by you or youth transported by you. No skates, bikes, scooters, or skate boards allowed.
10. **No alcohol** of any kind is allowed on the fairgrounds.
11. The **only** animals allowed in the showroom are rabbits and cavies (legally authorized service animals excluded from this rule).
12. **NO ANIMALS UNDER 6 WEEKS OF AGE ALLOWED IN THE SHOWROOM.**
13. The show committee reserves the right to add judges or make any substitutions as necessary.
14. All legs will be mailed; all specialty awards for sanctioned breeds (trophies, ribbons etc.) must be picked up the day of the show at the Specials Booth.

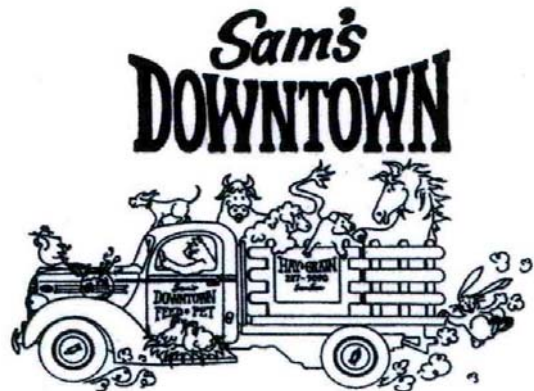
